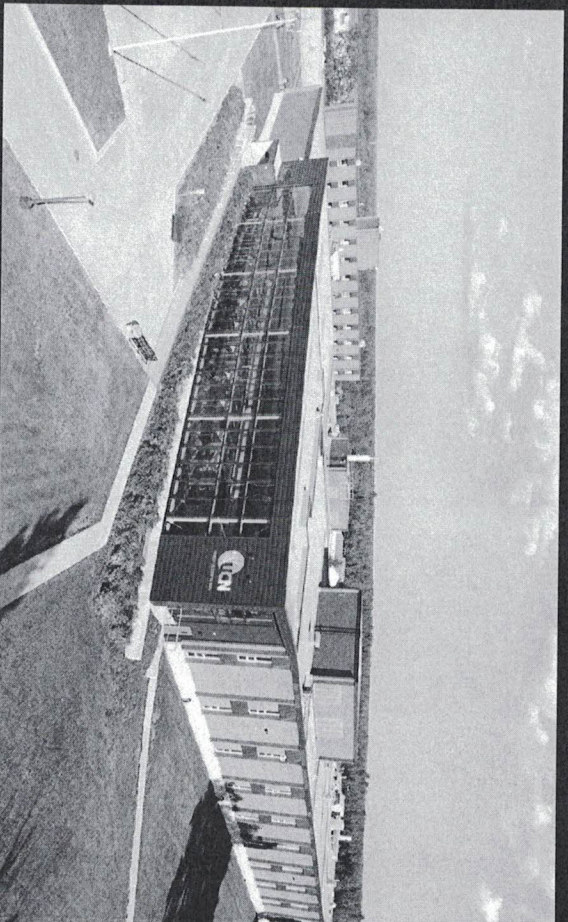
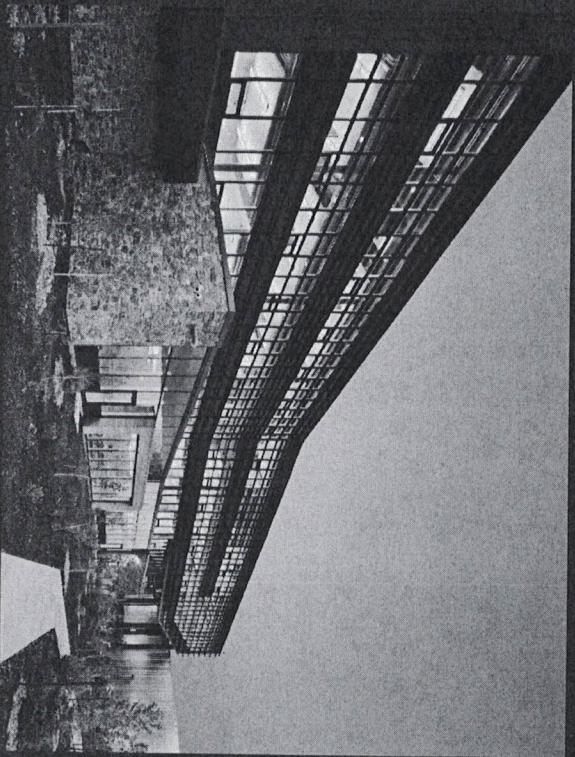

About UCN: Our Locations

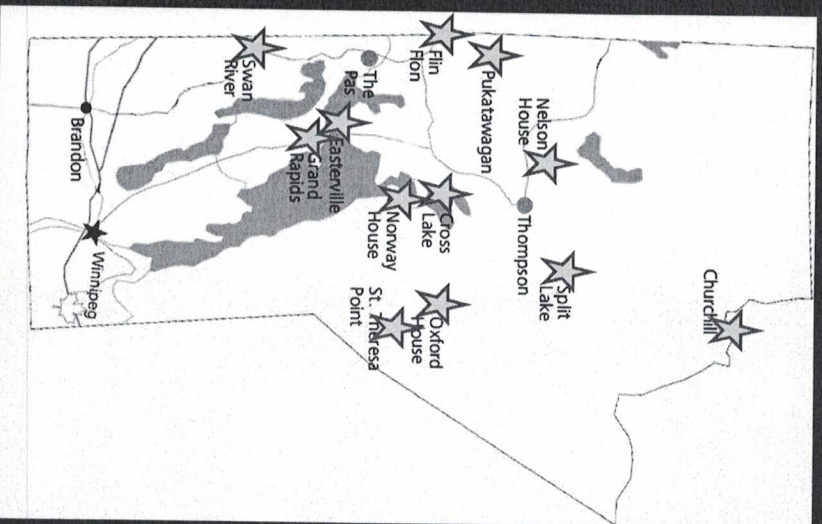

- Swan River

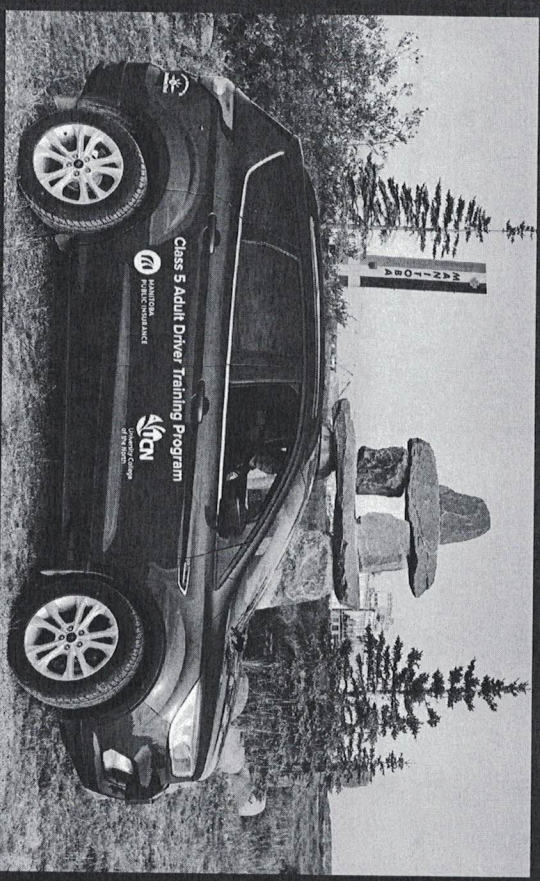
